### SPARKLING WINE

#### France

[NV] **Vignerons de Saumur - "49M" Brut Crémant de Loire/ Loire Valley** 10/32  
Chardonnay and Chenin apple and pear tones—dry but full of flavor. From a co-op of small farms

#### Italy

**2016 Furlan Castelcosa - Prosecco/ Veneto** 10/32  
Delicate, elegant bouquet—on the palate, dry, but with good ripe fruit—very high quality.

### DRY ROSÉ

#### France

**2016 Saint Roch Les Vignes/Côtes de Provence** 9/29  
Fresh aromas of cranberry and orange peel—proper acidity—a blend of Grenache/Cinsault.

**2016 Domaine d'Eole/ Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence** 12/38  
Certified organic—Complex aromas and flavors of citrus, and red flowers, crisp, long finish.

### WHITE WINES

#### France

**2016 La Chapiniere - Tourain Sauvignon Blanc/Loire Valley** 10/32  
Bright, luscious tropical fruit aromas give way to a crisp palate and snappy finish. Fooled me.

**2014 Domaine Paul Cherrier Père & Fils - Sancerre/Loire Valley** 49  
Sauvignon Blanc planted in Sancerre's flinty soils; fermented in 100% stainless steel. Mineral-driven and aromatic, steely acidity, citrus tones.

**2015 Guilhem Famille - Chardonnay/ Roussillon** 9/29  
Scents of white flowers and fruit, medium-bodied, no oak but nice mouthfeel.

**2015 Domaine de la Jobeline - Macon-Verze/ Mâconnais, Burgundy** 12/38  
Chardonnay from a very small village; secondary oak—full-bodied, citrus, minerals—long finish.

#### South Africa

**2015 Edgebaston - Stellenbosch Honey Shale Hill/ Stellenbosch** 10/32  
Sauvignon Blanc with Semillon, a bit of Viognier. Bright aromas of melon, white stone fruit.

#### Germany

**2015 Josef Drathen - Piesporter Michelsberg Kabinett Mosel** 8/26  
Aromas of pear, grapefruit, with flavors of green apple, honey and a refreshing finish.

#### Italy

**2016 Tenuto Fernando Cappello - Pinot Grigio/Grave, Friuli** 8/26  
Aromas of ripe melon, citrus, and toast—compact and savory in the mouth.

**2016 Stephanini - Garganega/Veneto** 9/29  
The grape of Soave—with a fresh, mouthwatering balance between fruit and acidity.

**2016 Montecariano - Valpolicella "La Madonna"/Veneto** 47  
Same grapes as Valpolicella. 100% organic farming, bright white peach and minerals on the nose—a bit of golden cherry on the palate, gorgeous finish.

**2008 Malvirà - Arneis "Trinità"/Roero, Piedmont** 52  
Single vineyard cru—nose of flowers, yellow peaches, and vanilla, flavors of grilled almonds and minerals—very long, complex finish. Unique

**2014 Sergio Mottura-Latour a Civitella/Lazio**  
From north of Rome. Rich golden color, elegant and complex nose, subtle flavors—hints of white fruit, citrus peel, melted butter, and hazelnut—quite full and velvety. Great alternative to Chardonnay. 55

#### Left Coast

**2016 Ryder Estate - Sauvignon Blanc/ Central Coast, CA** 9/29  
A fragrant, ripe melon aroma—lively and zesty on the palate, with lovely notes of citrus and a crisp, refreshing finish.

**2015 Davis Family Vineyards - Russian River Valley Cuvée Luke Saralee's Vineyard/ Sonoma, CA** 12/38  
Roussanne, Marsanne, and Viognier—Viscous and fresh with steely acidity and floral aroma; best New World white Rhone blend I've tasted.

**2016 Corvidae - Yakima Valley Chardonnay "Mirth"** 9/29  
Bright tropical notes, excellent purity of flavor and balance—fermented in stainless—no oak.

**2015 Carol Shelton - Wild Thing Chardonnay/Mendocino County, CA** 11/35  
Tropical fruit nose of pineapple and papaya—creamy mouthfeel and bright acidity.

**2014 Melville Vineyards - Sta. Rita Hills Estate Chardonnay/Santa Barbara, CA** 14/44  
Aromas of grilled lime, dried fruit, hint of vanilla and magnolia blossom; a rich and unctuous mouthfeel—not too creamy, with good balance.

**2013 Thomas Fogarty - Santa Cruz Mountains Estate Chardonnay/Santa Cruz, CA** 55  
Terrific stone fruits, citrus blossom, mineral and hints of toast to go with a medium-bodied, rich, textured and layered feel on the palate. The oak is subtle—plenty of richness.

## RED WINES

### France

#### Bourgogne

**2014 Jean-Claude Lapalu - Brouilly "Vieilles Vignes"/Cru Beaujolais** 54

80 yr-old, biodynamic Gamay vines in granite-rich soil. Intense blackberry syrup and crushed stone aromas; medium-bodied with fine, supple tannins.

**2016 Dom. de la Monette - "Sur Le Chateau" /Côte Chalonnaise** 13/41

Savory aromas of wet leather and ripe red cherry flavors—long finish. Pinot Noir from the source.

#### Rhone/Provence/Roussillon

**2016 Dom. Romarins/Côtes du Rhône** 9/29

Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvedre—This version is much darker and more full-bodied than most.

**2015 Dom. La Blaque - Pierrevert Rouge/Provence** 10/32

90/10 blend of Syrah and Grenache—aromas of blue fruit and smoke, dry, chewy tannins.

### Italy

#### Friuli-Venezia/Lombardy

**2012 Montecariano - Valpolicella Ripasso/Veneto** 56

Made in the traditional style by using the recioto skins to feed the second fermentation. Dark roast red cherry aromas combine with hints of smoke, leather and red fruit—balanced with minerality and proper acidity. Every sip gets better.

#### Piedmont

**2014 Malvirà - Nebbiolo/Langhe** 15/47

18-24 months in wood then 10 months in bottle before release. The nose offers brandied cherries and raspberries, with spice and tobacco—the mouth is rich, warm, and very dry. Try with food.

**2006 Malvirà - Nebbiolo/Langhe [375ml]** 29

The same wine as the 2014 (see above) but with mature aromas and flavors; red and black plums, soft spices, an almost creamy texture—with soft, smooth tannins. (Half-bottle)

#### Campagna

**2012 Ocone - Aglianico di Taburno "Apollo"/Campagna** 13/41

Classic red varietal of Napoli and the Vesuvio—full earthy flavors of dried cherries and smoke.

#### Tuscany

**2012 Villa Calcinaia - "Cappone"** 10/32

Family owned since 1524, Chianti Classico DOC, 100% Sangiovese—Dried herb, spice, and dusty earth scents—black plum and cherry flavors.

### South America

**2014 Vistalba—"Corte C" Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon/Mendoza, Argentina** 9/29

Juicy and tangy with bright blackberry fruit and notes of earth and spice; deep and lush.

## RED WINES

### Spain

**2015 Costers del Priorat-Priorat/Catalonia**

A subtle marriage of strength and complexity. Black fruit and forest floor, a palate of savory spice and smoked dark cocoa, long finish. 13/41

**2013 Bodegas Palacio—"Glorioso"/Rioja**

Aromas of red fruit and floral notes, cedarwood, and black pepper. On the palate; good attack, black fruit, with a long, delicious finish. 9/29

**2012 Bodegas Ego - "Infinito"/Jumilla** 14/44

Dense and chewy—Belgian chocolate, cherry, allspice; full-bodied with balanced tannins and acidity, oak-aged. Mostly Monastrell, some Cab.

### Left Coast

#### Cabernet Sauvignon

**2015 Rickshaw - Napa, Sonoma, and Paso Robles, CA** 9/29

A fusion of aromas including macerated cherries, violets, and cocoa followed by flavors of black cherry, framboise, espresso bean, and plum.

**2014 Goldschmidt Vineyards-Crazy Creek/Alexander Valley, CA** 13/41

Ripe aromas of blackberry, spice, licorice, and vanilla—flavors are accented with sage and dark chocolate; soft, supple tannins.

#### Merlot

**2014 Corvidae-The Rook/Columbia Valley, WA**

Black and red fruits, cinnamon and tobacco; fine grained tannin and a rich, soft mid-palate. 9/29

#### Pinot Noir

**2014 Thomas Henry-Sonoma/CA** 9/29

Aromas and flavors of cranberry sauce, ripe Bing cherries, cinnamon, sandalwood, and cola.

**2014 Yamhill Valley Vineyards - McMinnville/OR** 12/38

High toned red fruit, a rich, textured mid-palate, black cherry, deep black fruit qualities, and earthy aromatics. 100% estate fruit.

#### Zinfandel

**2015 Peirano-Old Vine Heritage, Lodi/Central Valley, CA** 9/29

Chocolate and Nutella on raisin toast; on the palate, sour cherries, and ripe black raspberries.

**2014 Brady Vineyards - Paso Robles/San Luis Obispo, CA** 12/38

Rich and luxurious, with aromas of raspberry and sweet oak along with subtle notes of vanilla and spice. Opulent texture, gentle acidity, and savory bramble berry flavors lengthen the finish.

**2014 Carol Shelton Wines - "Wild Thing" Old Vine/ Mendocino County, CA**

Maybe my favorite Zin-Master—60 year-old vines, wild yeasts and 35% new oak offer up aromas of black cherry, ripe plum and raspberry, with hints of vanilla-oak baking spice loveliness. Smoothly textured in the mouth, the palate is very creamy and round with a long jammy finish. 14/44
